- ※1 Alert level 5 may not always be issued because there are instances where municipalities are not aware of the extent of the disaster
- ※2 Evacuation Orders will be issued at the same stage as the previous alert level "Evacuation Advisory".
- ※3 Alert level 3 is the stage when those other than the elderly and disabled, may need to suspend their usual activity, begin preparing for evacuation, and evacuate at their own discretion if they feel in danger.

Alert Level 5 indicates a situation of life-threatening danger where safe evacuation is no longer possible.
Be sure to take measures to ensure safety before Alert Level 5 is reached!

“Evacuation Advisories” have been repealed.
From now on, all persons are required to evacuate at-risk areas upon issuance of an Alert Level 4 Evacuation Order,

Those such as elderly and disabled persons, who may need additional time to evacuate at-risk areas, please evacuate by Alert Level 3-Evacuation for elderly persons, etc.
